- We provide confidential services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault, including individuals and families, at no cost.
- We staff two 24-hour hotlines: One for domestic violence and one for sexual assault.
- We have a residential facility, Patricia House, to house individuals and families fleeing violence in their homes.
- We are on call 24/7/365.
- We provide on-site emergency response at local hospitals, police departments, and at court. Walk-ins are served at our main office at 2 West Street office in downtown Danbury.
- Our counseling services cover a broad range of topics such as self-esteem, ending relationships, separation and divorce, coping with stress and anxiety, bullying, and LGBTQ+ issues.
- We provide no cost education programs for all ages—from preschool to senior citizens.

  These programs are provided in schools, colleges, businesses, social and civic groups, and faith-based organizations.
- We are the only state-certified provider of these support services in our 11-town community: Bethel, Brookfield, New Milford, Redding, Roxbury, Bridgewater, Danbury, New Fairfield, Newtown, Ridgefield, and Sherman.
- We serve more than 30,000 individuals and families annually.
- We rely on donations for more than half the funds needed to run CEE, so we can be there for all those who turn to us for help.
